

Between 1961 and 1994, the 1067 series was used by ÖBB as a truly exotic locomotive. Only one prototype and four other machines of these electric locomotives were produced. They were equipped with a special technical feature: an electro-hydraulic drive. The electric locomotives built by Jenbacher Werke with a central driver's cab were used in shunting services and could be found in fir green or blood orange. The drive concept, which was strongly based on diesel locomotives, proved to be susceptible to defects and damage, which is why production was discontinued and locomotive 1067.03 was the last active locomotive to be taken out of service on October 1, 1994. Today, two of the vehicles can still be admired in the Knittelfeld and Ampflwang railroad museums.
