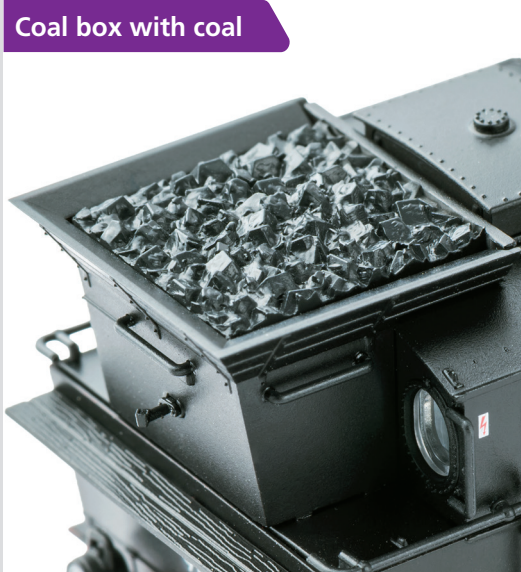

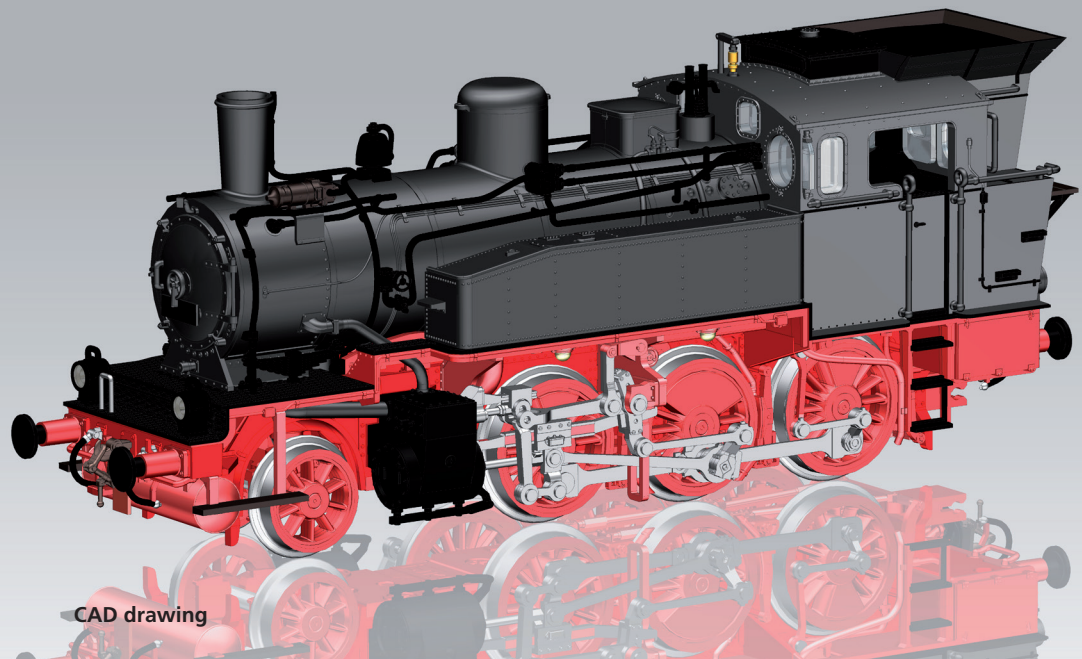

# Steam loco Class 91.3 DR III

The T 9.3 was a robust tank locomotive that proved equally capable in both passenger and freight service. With a top speed of 65 km/h, it was among the most powerful locomotives of its time and became one of the most widely produced locomotives in Germany. Starting in 1901, the Prussian State Railway ordered over 2,000 units of this proven type from the Königsberg Union Foundry. In 1925, the German Reichsbahn took over the majority of the locomotives into its fleet and classified them as Class 91. Over the course of their long service life, numerous locomotives were exported abroad, including to Czechoslovakia and Poland. After World War II, many units remained in Germany, where they reliably served until the 1960s and 1970s. With its combination of power, versatility, and solid engineering, the T 9.3 remains to this day a symbol of the engineering artistry of the early steam locomotive era — a true workhorse on the rails that made history.
